The Principal Provider/Applicant hereby agrees to compensate WBOPDC for damage to any pavement or structures on the local road (including but not limited to bridges and safety barriers) incurred in relation to the work. All work must comply with Health and Safety Act 1991 or any amendments thereto.</p> <p>The Principal Provider/Applicant agrees to contact Utility Service Providers so as to establish whether underground services may be affected by the proposed work and to ensure that exact locations of the services are confirmed on site. Note that information on Council owned services is available through Council's Customer Services. This consent is valid for 3 months from the date of issue. Fees apply – Refer WBOPDC Fees and Charges – Road Services.</p>
